Denise and John Wright for their generosity in welcoming *Sculpture in the Valley* to use their beautiful property *Cedar Grove* for the 2019 venue. It offers an intimate and rural setting as well as expansive views to showcase sculptural works and for visitors to enjoy.

The land parcel on which *Cedar Grove* sits was created by a land grant of 40 acres to John Jarrett in October 1879. Since that time the size of the property has been expanded to 120 acres and was used as a dairy farm until 2001 when the quota license was handed back to the authorities.

The main homestead is 10 years old, and it sits on the site of the original house. The second house, was a Manager's cottage which has been renovated in the past 6 years.

The farm buildings contain substantial dairy history and include an original barn, pig-shed and 3 dairy sheds that were built in different eras to accommodate newer procedures. The oldest building on the property is the original dairy shed with wooden troughs, long ago disused but a fine example of the era. We understand from the historical society that only 3 or 4 of these old dairies remain in the Valley.
